

Top 10 things to do on your BlackBerry® Pearl™ 8130 smartphone.

1. Integrate all your personal email accounts, such as Sympatico™, Yahoo!™ Mail or Gmail™.
 - Visit www.businessonthego.ca/myemail to integrate your personal email
 - Click on the setup wizard on your device and follows steps
2. Surf the Internet while on the go and access all your favourite Web sites.
 - Click the **Browser** icon and then type the URL of your choice or select the **BlackBerry HELP!** icon to access free games, weather and other helpful links.
 - 3. Get access to videos on YouTube™ Click the **Browser** icon and then type www.m.youtube.com
4. Listen to music or watch a video with the multimedia centre.
 - Click the **Media** icon, select **Music** or **Videos** then select **Sample Songs** or **Sample Videos**
 - If you have a mircoSD memory card, you can load your own pictures, music and videos onto the device using the Media Manager on the Desktop Manager CD included in the box
5. Get turn-by-turn directions with GPSNav from Bell.
 - Select the **GPS Nav** icon on the applications screen to download and install the application, a free 30 day trial is included
6. Chat live with friends using BlackBerry® Messenger or Windows Live® Messenger.
 - Select the **BlackBerry Messenger** icon, click the applications button, set up your profile, and add another BlackBerry user as a contact
 - Select the **Windows Live Messenger** icon to download and install application
7. Take a picture or make a video using the camera/video camera, then share it.
 - Select the **Camera or Video Camera** icon and take picture or record video, then click the **Envelope** icon and choose your delivery method
8. Make phone calls easily, using Voice Dialing.
 - Press the **convenience key** on left side of device (default setting) or click the applications button and select **Voice Dialing**, the follow the voice prompts
9. Use your BlackBerry smartphone as a modem for your laptop computer.
 - Download and install the **Mobile Connect** application from www.businessonthego.ca/mobileconnect
 - Connect your BlackBerry to your laptop via a USB cable and follow the directions to setup Mobile Connect
10. Record a voice memo using the Voice Notes Recorder.
 - Click the applications button and select **Voice Notes Recorder** then click the trackball to begin recording
