

New local calling area for the City of Sherbrooke.

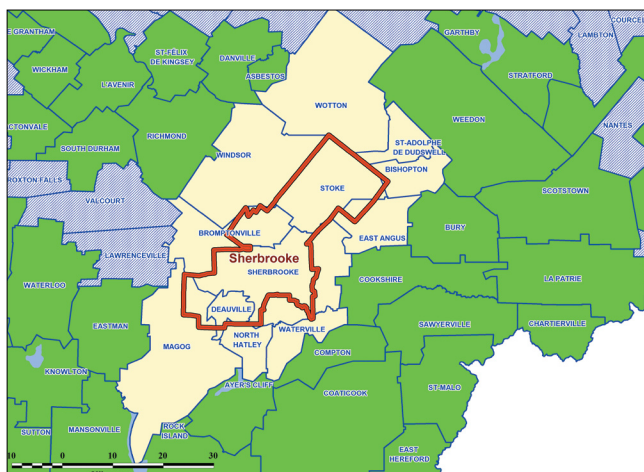
With the expansion of the Sherbrooke Local Calling Area (LCA), all customers within the City of Sherbrooke and surrounding areas will be able to call one another without incurring long distance charges.

Starting August 12, 2008, long distance charges will no longer be applied to calls placed within the new Sherbrooke LCA (refer to map below). They will be replaced with a temporary monthly fee of 20¢ per line for residential customers for the next 36 months. This fee will be collected by Bell and distributed to all participating long distance providers, as approved by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC).

Remember to reprogram your communications equipment (speed dial lists, faxes, modems, alarm systems, etc.), if applicable, to remove the "1" for long distance on or after August 12th.

Local calling capabilities vary by exchange. If you already enjoy local calling to areas outside the new, expanded LCA, you will continue to do so (that is, none of your current local calling capabilities will be lost with the expansion of your LCA).

Notes: Telephone exchange boundaries do not align with Municipal boundaries. None of your current local calling capabilities will be lost when your LCA is expanded.
