

New local calling area for Greater Sudbury.

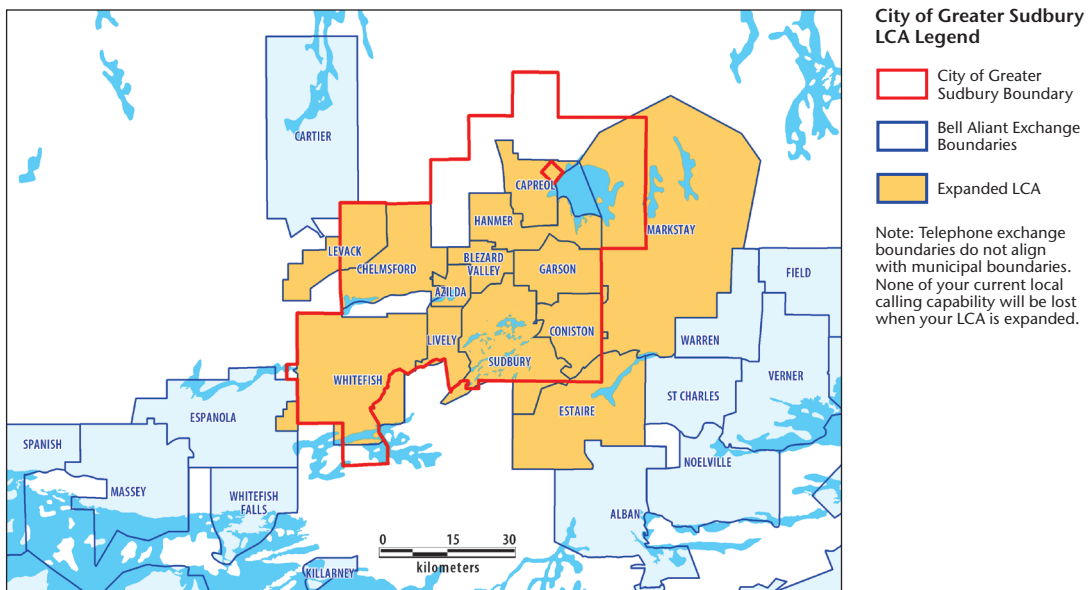
With the expansion of the Greater Sudbury Local Calling Area (LCA), all customers within the City of Greater Sudbury and surrounding areas will be able to call one another without incurring long distance charges.

Starting April 8, 2008, long distance charges will no longer be applied to calls placed within the new Greater Sudbury LCA (refer to map below). They will be replaced with a temporary monthly fee of 38¢ per line for businesses for the next 36 months. This fee will be collected by Bell and distributed to all participating long distance providers, as approved by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC).

Remember to reprogram your communications equipment (speed dial lists, faxes, modems, alarm systems, etc.) and, if applicable, remove the "1" for long distance on or after April 8th.

Local calling capabilities vary by exchange. If you already enjoy local calling to areas outside the new, expanded LCA, you will continue to do so (that is, none of your current local calling capability will be lost with the expansion of your LCA).
